RE: Authority for the County of Westchester to enter into an Agreement with Charles H. Mack & Associates, Inc. to provide Application Software Enhancement Upgrades and Software Maintenance Support for the existing Charles H. Mack Medical/Home Care System in an amount not to exceed \$60,000 to be paid pursuant to an approved budget and subject to appropriation for the period January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2012

Attached for your consideration is a resolution which, if approved by your Honorable Board, would authorize the County of Westchester ("Licensee") to enter into an agreement with Charles H. Mack & Associates, Inc. ("Licensor") to provide Application Software Enhancement Upgrades and Software Maintenance Support ("Q-Mack") for the existing Charles H. Mack Medical/Home Care System in an amount not to exceed \$60,000 for the period January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2012. There has been no increase in the amount requested for this program in 2012.

Under the proposed agreement, the Licensor would provide the County with application software enhancement upgrades to the existing Medical/Home Care System in order to comply with the New York State Department of Health's new Medicaid payment system called eMedNY. Upgrading of the system is required to meet the guidelines set by the New York State Department of Health.

The **public purpose** of this agreement is to assist the Department in complying with the guidelines set by the New York State Department of Health as regards Medicaid payments.

The **goals and objectives** of this contract are to support, upgrade and enhance an existing Medical/Home Care system in order to comply with the New York State Department of Health's new Medicaid payment system, eMedNY.

The **goals and objectives are in the best interests of the County** in terms of **public health** as they enable the Department of Social Services' Medicaid Unit to improve its delivery to the eligible public and to successfully manage its caseload of over 4,000 clients including social assessments, nursing assessments, supervisory assessments, plans of care, doctors' orders and payments to the vendors.

The **goals and objectives are continuously monitored** through the offices of Medical Home Care Services and Information Technology. No application specification is implemented until it is reviewed, amended, if necessary, and signed off by Department of Social Services staff.

The Department is able to report that in 2011, Charles H. Mack & Associates, Inc. performed satisfactorily with the ongoing provision of a first level Product Support desk to respond directly to any questions or requests from the Office of Medical Home Care Services. They successfully managed the resolution of all problems in the system and they continue to provide product upgrades as requested.

This Agreement is exempt from the Westchester County Procurement Policy pursuant to Section 9 thereof as this is the only vendor of its kind providing the aforesaid services in the region.

Accordingly, authority is requested for the County of Westchester to enter into an agreement with Charles H. Mack & Associates, Inc. for the aforesaid purpose.

A resolution requesting the same is attached for your Honorable Board's approval.

RESOLUTION

Upon a communication from the Commissioner of the Department of Social Services and the Chief Information Officer, Department of Information Technology, be it hereby

RESOLVED, that the County of Westchester (“Licensee”) is hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement with Charles H. Mack & Associates Inc. (“Licensor”) to provide Application Software Enhancement Upgrades and Software Maintenance Support for the existing Charles H. Mack Medical/Home Care System for the period January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2012 in an amount not-to-exceed \$60,000 (the “Agreement”) to be paid pursuant to an approved budget; and be it further

RESOLVED, that based on the representations of the Commissioners of Social Services and Information Technology, this Agreement is exempt from the Westchester County Procurement Policy pursuant to Section 9 (Sole Source) of said Policy as this is the only vendor providing the necessary services in the region; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this Contract is subject to County Appropriation; and be it further,

RESOLVED, that this agreement is also subject to further financial analysis of the impact of any New York State Budget (the “State Budget”) proposed and adopted during the term of this agreement. The County shall retain the right, upon the occurrence of any release by the Governor of a proposed State Budget and/or the adoption of a State Budget or any amendments thereto, and for a reasonable period of time after such release (s) or adoption (s), to conduct an analysis of the impacts of any such State Budget on County finances. After such analysis, the County shall retain the right to either terminate this agreement or to renegotiate the amounts and rates approved herein. If the County subsequently offers to pay a reduced amount to the Contractor, then the Contractor shall have the right to terminate this agreement upon reasonable prior written notice; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized designee is hereby authorized to execute all instruments and take all actions reasonably necessary to effectuate the purposes hereof.
