The 2012 Operating Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required to perform pavement sweeping and litter removal services from all paved surfaces, including the boardwalk areas in their entirety, and, all non-paved surfaces, excluding the beach, within the boundary of the park. This contract is for a term of three (3) years with one two (2) year renewal at the discretion of the County.

The objective of this contract is to maintain the park in a clean and litter free state.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by providing a clean and contamination free park, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Health and the Environment (HE).

This project will provide an environmental benefit by eliminating the potential for contamination of both the park and Long Island Sound.

As expenditures are made pursuant to this authorization, detailed records will be kept in the County's on-line financial system. These records will be easily accessible by Finance, Budget and department staff and will be reviewed regularly to ensure that funds are used appropriately.

RESOLUTION

RESOLVED, that the Acting Commissioner of Public Works and Transportation be and he hereby is authorized to solicit bids by public advertisement on the following contract:

and be it further

RESOLVED, that adequate and sufficient security for the faithful performance of this contract shall be deemed to be receipt of a performance and payment bond in an amount equal to 30% of the total contract amount, and in a form approved by the County Attorney. The Bond Underwriter or Surety must appear on the U.S. Treasury's listing of approved sureties (Department Circular 570) and all Sureties must be licensed to transact business in New York as a surety company; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this advertisement for bids will state that pursuant to Chapter 308 of the Laws of the County of Westchester, the policy of the County is to encourage the meaningful and significant participation on County contracts for business enterprises owned by persons of color and women - Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) and Women Business Enterprise (WBE); and be it further
