The 2012 Capital Account contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required for the installation of streambank devices such as boulder vane, stone barb, stone revetment and boulder toe stabilization. All disturbed areas will be re-graded and planted with native species appropriate to wetland and floodplain areas.

The objective of this contract is to stabilize streambanks at Scout Field, using a combination of structural techniques along with restoration of the existing freshwater wetland.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will provide an environmental benefit by reducing flooding and erosion, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Health and the Environment (HE).

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.
