On June 14, 2012, Commissioner Jay T. Pisco, P.E., notified your Honorable Board of an emergency situation involving the Fulton Avenue Bridge over Eastchester Creek in the City of Mount Vernon and the Village of Pelham Manor.

Due to a sudden deterioration of the bridge's two (2) drive systems, this bascule-type bridge can no longer operate. The bridge is currently in the open position in order to meet navigable waterway requirements and a traffic detour has been established. This has resulted in a potential imminent danger to life, health and safety because of delays in police, ambulance and fire response.

It is imperative to complete this emergency work immediately in order to restore the bridge to its normal operation and to re-open the bridge to emergency service vehicles and the traveling public.

In accordance with the emergency contracting procedures utilized since April 8, 2002, the Department of Public Works and Transportation immediately prepared documents to solicit bids from responsible contractors on the County's Emergency Contractor List and requested bids from four (4) contractors on that list. Two (2) contractors attended the site inspection and submitted bids. Healy Electric Contracting, Inc., 4 Fisher Lane, White Plains, New York 10603 submitted the low bid in the amount of \$48,020.00.

The objective of this contract is to effect those repairs that are necessary to restore the bridge to its normal operation and to re-open the bridge to emergency service vehicles and the traveling public.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.

Therefore, it is requested that your Honorable Board grant authorization for the Commissioner of Public Works and Transportation to enter into an emergency contract with Healy Electric Contracting, Inc., 4 Fisher Lane, White Plains, New York 10603 for a total cost not-to-exceed \$48,020.00.
