The 2012 Non-Recurring Account contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required to remove and install a new concrete spill and containment pad along with improvements to drainage systems. Work also includes new curbing and sidewalks.

The objective of this contract is to provide a new concrete pad at the plant's grit loading area.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by ensuring that the plant's operations meet all safety regulations, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Safety and Security (SS). There are no energy or environmental components associated with this project.
