The 2012 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required for the complete removal and replacement of the bridge's arch spandrel walls along with concrete patching and waterproofing of the arch, replacement of the bridge rail, and full-depth pavement replacement. Additionally, the bridge is to be widened to accommodate a sidewalk for pedestrian access on the bridge while the existing prefabricated truss bridge will be removed due to its poor condition.

The objective of this contract is to repair substandard structural elements of the Croton Falls Road Bridge, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Safety and Security (SS).

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by ensuring that the Croton Falls Road Bridge meets current codes and standards as well as reducing the County's annual maintenance costs.

The project will provide an environmental benefit with the installation of a bio-retention pond to maintain the existing water quality conditions and to offset the increased impervious area added to the bridge.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.
