Re: Authority to amend an affiliation agreement with Michael Malotz Skilled Nursing Pavilion to include supervised laboratory/clinical education and instruction for the Dietetic Tech Program

Westchester Community College (the “College”) has an existing agreement with St. John’s Riverside Hospital (“St. John’s Riverside”) whereby the College, in conjunction with St. John’s Riverside offers supervised laboratory/clinical education and instruction for matriculated Westchester Community College students who are pursuing a degree or certificate in this program’s various organizations. The program that is currently offered is in the area of Respiratory Care. The agreement commenced January 1, 2009 and will expire December 31, 2013.

Authority is requested to amend this agreement in order to include the Dietetic Tech Program as part of the agreement. All other terms and conditions shall remain the same.

There will be no cost to the College, but the parties will cross indemnify each other for their respective negligence.

I believe that it is in the best interest of the College to provide clinical education and instruction programs; and I therefore, recommend that you act favorably on the annexed proposed resolution.
