Re: Authority for the County of Westchester to enter into an agreement with the Westchester County Health Care Corporation whereby the Westchester Community College will assign students who are pursuing a degree or certificate program of study in the health care field with concentrations in radiologic technology, respiratory care, paramedics, nursing and surgical technology program to WCHCC for supervised clinical education for a five year term commencing upon execution.

Attached for your consideration is a Resolution which seeks authority for the County of Westchester, acting by and through the Westchester Community College ("College"), to enter into an agreement with the Westchester County Health Care Corporation ("WCHCC"), whereby the College assigns students who are pursuing a degree or certificate program of study in the health care field with concentrations in radiologic technology, respiratory care, paramedics, nursing and surgical technology program to WCHCC for supervised clinical education. The term of this Agreement shall be for five years commencing upon execution. There will be no cost to the County.

As you are aware Section 3307(4) of the New York Public Authorities Law requires the approval of the Board of Legislators and Board of Acquisition and Contract for agreements between the County and WCHCC. The Westchester County Board of Legislators authorized this agreement by Act 2013-38 on March 11, 2013.

Accordingly, I recommend adoption of the annexed resolution.

RESOLUTION

Upon a communication from Joseph N. Hankin, President of Westchester Community College, be it hereby

RESOLVED, that the County of Westchester, acting by and through the Westchester Community College ("College") is authorized to enter into an agreement with the Westchester County Health Care Corporation ("WCHCC"), whereby the College shall assign students who are pursuing a degree or certificate program of study in the health care field with concentrations in radiologic technology, respiratory care, paramedics, nursing and surgical technology program to WCHCC for supervised clinical education; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the term of this Agreement will be for five years commencing upon execution; and there will be no cost to the County; and be it further

RESOLVED, that except for the amount of damages, if any, caused by, or resulting from WCC's own negligence, the County will indemnify WCHCC for its own and its student's acts or omissions; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized designee is hereby authorized to execute any documents and take any actions reasonably necessary and appropriate to effectuate the purposes of this Resolution.
