On December 12, 2012, six (6) bids were received and opened for Contract No. 12-206 for Pump Station Rehabilitation, Oak Street, Yonkers, New York.

The bids were reviewed by the Department and it was determined that Southeast Mechanical Corp. submitted the low bid in the amount of \$178,975.00, and has proposed the utilization of the following subcontractor: Black Electric Inc. (Electrical Work), 766 Freedom Plains Road, Poughkeepsie, New York 12603.

The low bidder has been investigated and it has been found that Southeast Mechanical Corp.:

- Performed satisfactory work in the past for the County.
 Past experience has been investigated and found satisfactory.

The objective of this contract is to rebuild the Oak Street Pump Station.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will allow for the Bronx River Parkway to remain operational during periods of high rainfall.

This project will provide an environmental benefit by reducing flooding on the Bronx River Parkway at the Oak Street overpass, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Health and the Environment (HE).

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.

It is my recommendation that Contract No. 12-206 be awarded to Southeast Mechanical Corp. in the amount of \$178,975.00.

RESOLUTION

CONTRACT NO. 12-206

Upon communication from the Commissioner of Public Works and Transportation, be it

RESOLVED, that Contract No. 12-206 for Pump Station Rehabilitation, Oak Street, Yonkers, New York be and is hereby awarded to the low bidder, Southeast Mechanical Corp., 568 North Main Street, Brewster, New York 10509, in the amount of \$178,975.00; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the use of the following subcontractor also be approved: Black Electric Inc. (Electrical Work), 766 Freedom Plains Road, Poughkeepsie, New York 12603; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this contract is subject to County appropriations; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this Agreement is also subject to further financial analysis of the impact of any New York State Budget (the "State Budget") proposed and adopted during the term of this Agreement. The County shall retain the right, upon the occurrence of any release by the Governor of a proposed State Budget and/or the adoption of a State Budget or any amendments thereto, and for a reasonable period of time after such release(s) or adoption(s), to conduct an analysis of the impacts of any such State Budget on County finances. After such analysis, the County shall retain the right to either terminate this Agreement or to renegotiate the amounts and rates approved herein. If the County subsequently offers to pay a reduced amount to the Contractor, then the Contractor shall have the right to terminate this Agreement upon reasonable prior written notice; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his authorized designee is hereby authorized and empowered to execute any and all documents necessary or appropriate to effectuate the purposes hereof.
