TEE Authority to enter into an agreement with Al Sorano d/b/a Al Sorano's Re:

Professional Truck Driving School for the provision of driver education training on a fee for service basis for a three (3) year term with the option to extend for an

additional one year term.

On January 10, 2013, the Educational Opportunity Center of Westchester Community College ("EOC") issued a request for proposals seeking driver education training for students enrolled its Emergency Medical Technician, Direct Support Professional, and Commercial Driver's License programs ("RFP"). The RFP was sent to twelve (12) driving schools in the metropolitan area. EOC received four (4) responses but only one (1) proposal. The three other responses were in the form of a "Non-Bidders Response". One said that they had insufficient time to prepare the response even though they had 1 month to prepare the response. The other two said they could not meet the specifications contained within the RFQ, one because they would not send an instructor to the EOC Yonkers site and the other simply stated that they couldn't meet the specifications.

The sole proposal, received from Al Sorano d/b/a Al Sorano's Professional Truck Driving School ("Sorano"), meets the needs of the EOC and complies with the specifications contained in the RFP. The term of the proposed agreement would commence on or about April 1, 2013 and the agreement would continue for 3 years, with the College having the opportunity to extend the term for an additional year at the same pricing, terms and conditions. Sorano shall be paid an amount not to exceed \$255,000 for the initial three year term, payable at the rates contained in Schedule "A".

The public purpose of this agreement is to provide the training required to enable EOC students to obtain a Class D driver's license and/or a Class C and/or B commercial driver's license so that they are able to secure employment that requires related credentials. The value of entering into this agreement will be tracked based on the number of students successfully completing the coursework and receiving the appropriate licenses.
