On June 05, 2013 one bid was received for Contract EF-1302 for the removal and disposal of hazardous, chemical, and universal waste at various Department locations, Westchester County, New York. The contract is for two (2) years with an option to extend for one (1) additional two year term by mutual consent of the Contractor and the County of Westchester with all prices, terms and conditions remaining the same as the original contract commencing July 24, 2013 to July 23, 2015.

There was only one bid submitted due to the specialty work required in this contract. The other contractors, who had downloaded the contract bid documents and were expected to bid, ultimately did not submit bids.

The objective of the Contract is to obtain the services of a contractor who is responsible for the proper packaging, labeling, and transportation of hazardous waste materials from a Department facility to the ultimate disposal site. The contractor is to ensure that all waste goes to a properly permitted site and that manifests and any other required documentation is provided to the Department as proof of proper disposal. Each site pickup will include a written service report, which will be signed off by a Department representative and will serve as verification that the work was performed. Signed verification is for payment and tracking purposes only and in

no way relieves the Contractor from the responsibility of completing the work as described herein. The Contractor must comply with all applicable EPA, OSHA, and DOT rules and regulations.

Issuing this contract promotes the health and safety of County residents and employees and is also environmentally beneficial. The bid was reviewed by the Department and it was determined that EQ Northeast, Inc. submitted the sole bid in the amount of \$64,886.20. The sole bidder has performed satisfactory work in the past for the County.

Upon communication from the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Facilities, be it hereby

RESOLVED: that Contract No. EF-1302 for removal and disposal of hazardous waste from various Department of Environmental Facilities locations for a period of two (2) years with an option to extend for one (1) additional two year term by mutual consent of the Contractor and the County of Westchester with all prices, terms and conditions remaining the same as the original contract is awarded to the sole bidder, EQ Northeast, Inc., 185 Industrial Rd, Wrentham, MA 02093, in the amount of \$64,886.20 commencing July 24, 2013 to July 23, 2015, subject to the adoption of the Operating Budgets; and be it further

RESOLVED: that this Agreement is subject to County appropriations; and be it further

RESOLVED: that this Agreement subject to further financial analysis of the impact of any New York State Budget (the "State Budget") proposed and adopted during the term of this Agreement. The County shall retain the right, upon the occurrence of any release by the Governor of a proposed State Budget and/or the adoption of a State Budget or any amendments thereto, and for a reasonable period of time after such release(s) or adoption(s), to conduct analysis, the County shall retain the right to either terminate this Agreement or to renegotiate the amounts and rates approved herein. If the County subsequently offers to pay a reduced amount to the Contractor, then the Contractor shall have the right to terminate this Agreement upon reasonable prior written notice; and be it further

RESOLVED: that the County Executive or his authorized designee is hereby authorized and empowered to execute any and all documents necessary or appropriate to effectuate the purposes hereof.
