RE: AUTHORITY TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR SERVICES FOR FUEL SYSTEMS AND RELATED EQUIPMENT AT VARIOUS DEPARTMENT OF PARKS, RECREATION AND CONSERVATION FACILITIES

The 2013 Operating Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required to furnish maintenance and repair services for vehicle fueling systems and fuel oil systems at various Department of Parks, Recreation and Conservation facilities. The contract also includes all fuel monitoring and dispensing systems. This contract is for a term of three (3) years with one two (2) year renewal at the discretion of the County.

The objective of this contract is to maintain the operation of fuel systems at Department of Parks, Recreation and Conservation facilities.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by providing for safe and code compliant fuel systems, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Safety and Security (SS). There are no energy or environmental components in the project.

As expenditures are made pursuant to this authorization, detailed records will be kept in the County's online financial system. These records will be easily accessible by Finance, Budget and department staff and will be reviewed regularly to ensure that funds are used appropriately.

A resolution requesting the same is attached for your Honorable Board's favorable consideration.

RESOLUTION

Upon a communication from the Commissioner of Parks, Recreation and Conservation, be it hereby

RESOLVED, that the Department of Parks, Recreation and Conservation is hereby authorized to solicit bids by public advertisement for the following contract:

and be it further

RESOLVED, that adequate and sufficient security for the faithful performance of this contract shall be deemed to be receipt of a performance and payment bond in an amount equal to 30% of the total contract amount, and in a form approved by the County Attorney. The Bond Underwriter or Surety must appear on the U.S. Treasury's listing of approved sureties (Department Circular 570) and all Sureties must be licensed to transact business in New York as a surety company; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this advertisement for bids will state that pursuant to Section 308 of the Laws of Westchester County, it is the goal of the County to encourage the meaningful and significant participation on County contracts for business enterprises owned by persons of color and women Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) and Women Business Enterprise (WBE); and be it further
