Re: Authority is hereby requested for the County of Westchester to enter into agreements with nine (9) licensed consultants as listed in Schedule "A" to provide psychological testing and evaluations, psychiatric evaluations, sibling consults, fire setting evaluations, safety assessments and court ordered psychotherapy to uninsured or under insured parents and children who have been subjects of Child Protective Service Reports and families in which at least one (1) child is at risk of foster care placement or, in which at least one (1) child has been placed in foster care for the period January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014 in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$217,125 to be paid at rates listed in Schedule "B" pursuant to an approved budget and subject to appropriation

Authority is hereby requested for the County of Westchester to enter into agreements with nine (9) licensed consultants as listed in Schedule "A" to provide psychological testing and evaluations, psychiatric evaluations, sibling consults, fire setting evaluations, safety assessments and court ordered psychotherapy to uninsured or under insured parents and children who have been subjects of Child Protective Service Reports and families in which at least one (1) child is at risk of foster care placement or, in which at least one (1) child has been placed in foster care for the period January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014 in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$217,125 to be paid at rates listed in Schedule "B" pursuant to an approved budget and subject to appropriation. The not to exceed amount for 2014 is the same as the previous year.

All consultants are paid at an hourly rate for the actual time spent in reviewing records, interviews, conferences, interpreting test results and preparation of reports. The Consultants shall be available at the request of the County Attorney, to testify in Family Court or other related proceedings as to the

Consultants' evaluative findings and/or assessment of therapeutic progress. The Consultants will be compensated for such time and appearance required by the Department.

The contracts with the licensed Consultants serve a **public purpose** by assisting the Department and the Family Court to decide what is in the best interest of the child(ren). Examples of these decisions are: whether a child should be placed under the supervision of the court or be placed in or continue with foster care, or to terminate the parental rights.

The **goals and objectives** of these contracts are to provide psychological testing and evaluations, psychiatric evaluations, sibling consults, fire setting evaluations, safety assessments and court ordered psychotherapy to uninsured or under insured parents and children who have been subjects of Child Protective Service reports, and families in which at least one child is at risk of foster care placement or, in which at least one child has been placed in foster care. The services provided by the Consultants allow for interventions that promote the psychological and physical well-being of the child(ren) and/or parent(s) in order for families to safely maintain their children at home.

The **goals and objectives are in the best interests of the County in terms of public health and public safety** because they are aimed at providing clinical evaluations of the children and parents referred to the Consultants. These evaluations help the Department to identify the mental health and/or developmental problems of the children and parents and make appropriate referrals which in turn help to reduce the risk of abuse, neglect or maltreatment and focus on the ability of the parent(s) or guardian(s) to provide a safe and nurturing home environment.

The **goals and objectives are in the best interests of the County in terms of fiscal responsibility** in that the services provided by the Consultant assist the Department in determining the appropriate level of services needed by the children and families, thereby helping to avert costly out of home placements. Further, since the services will be provided at an hourly rate, payments will be made for the actual time the Consultants spend on each case which in turn would result in more accountability on the part of the Department and the Consultants.

The **goals and objectives of this program will be tracked and monitored** using the Performance Measurement Indicators developed by the Department and approved by the County Budget Office. They include feedback from District Office staff as well as the review of monthly performance reports submitted by the Consultants.

Based on the **Performance Measurement Indicators submitted** each month, the Department is able to report that the Consultants have met the established milestones set forth in the Scope of Work and the Program staff is satisfied with the outcomes.

These contracts are exempt from the Westchester County Procurement Policy pursuant to Section 3(a) (vii) and (viii). These contracts are also exempt from the application of the Common Grant Rule as they fall under the Social Service Block Grant.

Accordingly, the County of Westchester is hereby requesting permission to enter into agreements with nine (9) licensed consultants as described above.

We respectfully request your Honorable Board's approval of the attached Resolution.

RESOLUTION

Upon a communication from the Commissioner of the Department of Social Services, be it hereby

RESOLVED, that the County of Westchester is hereby authorized to enter into agreements with nine (9) licensed consultants as listed in Schedule "A" to provide psychological testing and evaluations, psychiatric evaluations, sibling consults, fire setting evaluations, safety assessments and court ordered psychotherapy to uninsured and under insured parents and children who have been subjects of Child Protective Service Reports and families in which at least one (1) child is at risk of foster care placement or, in which at least one (1) child has been placed in foster care for the period January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014 in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$217,125 to be paid at rates listed in Schedule "B" pursuant to an approved budget; and be it further

RESOLVED, that these agreements are subject to County Appropriations; and be it further

RESOLVED, that these agreements are also subject to further financial analysis of the impact of any New York State Budget (the "State Budget") proposed and adopted during the term of these agreements. The County shall retain the right, upon the occurrence of any release by the Governor of a proposed State Budget and/or the adoption of a State Budget or any amendments thereto, and for a reasonable period of time after such release(s) or adoption(s), to conduct an analysis of the impacts of any such State Budget on County finances. After such analysis, the County shall retain the right to either terminate these agreements or renegotiate the amounts and rates approved herein. If the County subsequently offers to pay a reduced amount to the Consultant, then the Consultant shall have the right to terminate the agreement upon reasonable prior written notice; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his authorized designee is empowered to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the purposes hereof.
