On March 12, 2014, fourteen (14) bids were received and opened for Contract No. 14-505 for Mews II Clayton Boulevard Infrastructure Improvement Project, Town of Somers, New York.

The bids were reviewed by the Department and it was determined that ELQ Industries, Inc. submitted the low bid in the amount of \$1,567,335.00.

The low bidder has been investigated and it has been found that ELQ Industries, Inc.:

- Performed satisfactory work in the past for the County.

The objective of this contract is to construct public infrastructure to further affordable housing, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Fiscal Responsibility (FR).
