RE: Authority to enter into an Agreement with Single Stop USA to accept a grant in the amount of \$50,000 to be used to provide free tax preparation services at Westchester Community College for the program period January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014

The County of Westchester (the "County"), acting by and through the Department of Social Services, Workforce Investment Board (the "Department"), seeks authority from your Honorable Board to enter into an agreement with Single Stop USA ("SSUSA") to accept a grant (the "Grant") in the amount of \$50,000 to support a free tax preparation campaign for college students at Westchester Community College ("WCC") for the program period January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014.

As your Honorable Board may know, since 2004, the County, in collaboration with several community partners, has offered a free tax preparation service called the Westchester County Volunteer Income Tax Assistance Program ("VITA"). VITA was designed to help low/moderate income individuals, families with children and elderly residents prepare their tax returns for free, thus enabling them to take advantage of various tax credits they may not have been aware of. Using proceeds from the Grant, the Westchester VITA program, in partnership with WCC and SSUSA, will provide free tax preparation services to community college students and student households in need at a tax site located on the WCC campus. It is hoped that by making such services available to college students and the family members on campus, the number of students able to successfully complete their studies will be dramatically increased.

SSUSA will receive its funding through the WCC Foundation. The funding will thereafter be paid to the Department in four (4) installments over the course of 12 months. The Department will use proceeds from the grant to hire tax preparers who

will provide services to WCC students at the WCC campus, pursuant to separate contracts.

The proposed agreement serves a **public purpose** by assisting eligible students and their families who work and have income that falls below the specified level to take advantage of the free tax services and receive the maximum tax credits.

The **goals and objectives** of these Agreements will help the County reach its goal to prepare up to 1,000 returns for the WCC students.

The goals and objectives are in the best interests of the County in terms of **fiscal responsibility** because at no cost to the County, the students will be able to receive the maximum federal and state tax credits. Further the goal of this outreach will help each eligible resident to receive between \$653 and \$8,106 in tax credit based on the family size, marital status, and earned income. It has been determined that for every \$1 of tax credits earned, \$2 is spent in the local economy.

The goals and objectives will be tracked and monitored through monthly reports. The agencies will report on the number of returns filed, the amount tax refunds and the amount of EITC and other tax credits.

It should be noted that the proposed grant agreement does not constitute procurement. As such, the provisions of the Westchester County Procurement Policy do not apply.

Accordingly, I recommend adoption of the proposed annexed resolution.
