SUBJECT: Authority to, exercise the County's option to extend the term of an agreement with Three D Industrial Maintenance Corp. for one two (2) year option period, thereby increasing the amount of the agreement by \$334,396.00 and extending the term of the agreement through March 31, 2017. (Contract No. 12-203)

By resolution approved on April 5, 2012 (the "April 5th Resolution"), your Honorable Board awarded Contract No. 12-203 to Three D Industrial Maintenance Corp. ("Three D Industrial"). The April 5th Resolution authorized the County of Westchester (the "County") to enter into Contract No. 12-203 with Three D Industrial, pursuant to which Three D Industrial was to provide Pavement Sweeping and Litter Removal Services for Playland Park in Rye, New York, for the amount of \$501,594.00, for the period April 12, 2012 through April 11, 2015, ("Contract No. 12-203" or the "Agreement"), with the County having the sole option to extend the Agreement for one (1) two (2) year option period.

The County now seeks authority from your Honorable Board to exercise the two (2) year renewal option , and thereby, 1) increasing the amount of the Agreement by \$334,396.00 from an amount of \$501,594.00 to a new amount of \$835,990.00, and 2) extending the termination date of the Agreement from April 11, 2015 to March 31, 2017.

All other terms and conditions of the April 5, 2012 Resolution and the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect and unchanged.

The Agreement is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by providing a clean and contamination free park, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Health and the Environment (HE).

As expenditures are made pursuant to this authorization, detailed records will be kept in the County's on-line financial system. These records will be easily accessible by Finance, Budget and department staff and will be reviewed regularly to ensure that funds are used appropriately.

RESOLUTION

CONTRACT NO. 12-203

Upon a communication from the Commissioner of the Department of Public Works and Transportation, be it hereby

RESOLVED, that the County is authorized to exercise its two (2) year renewal option for Contract 12-203 with Three D Industrial Maintenance Corp., 3 Browns Lane, Hawthorne, New York 10532 for Pavement Sweeping and Litter Removal Services for Playland Park in Rye, New York , and thereby, a) increasing the amount of the Agreement by \$334,396.00, from \$501,594.00 to \$835,990.00, and b) extending the termination date of the Agreement from April 11, 2015 to March 31, 2017; and be it further

RESOLVED, that except as specifically amended hereby, all remaining terms and conditions of the April 5, 2012 Resolution and the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect and unchanged; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized designee is hereby authorized to execute all documents and take all actions necessary to effectuate the purpose hereof.
