The 2015 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required for the rehabilitation of the East Basin, West Basin and Edgewater Point Pump Stations, including but not limited to, demolition, installation of new electrical and instrumentation equipment, installation of new heating and ventilating equipment, major mechanical equipment replacement, and flood mitigation at each station.

In accordance with Local Law No. 1-1998, the Department of Public Works and Transportation has evaluated the needs of this project and determined that a Project Labor Agreement (PLA) will benefit and enhance the interests of the County in the timely and efficient completion of the project. The Contractor to whom this contract is awarded will be required to execute a PLA.

The objective of this contract is to upgrade and rehabilitate pump stations in the Mamaroneck Sewer District.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will ensure that the County's operations are safe and environmentally compliant, thereby enhancing the health and general welfare of County residents, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Health and the Environment (HE).

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.
