SUBJECT: Authority to amend a resolution approved on September 5, 2013, as amended by resolutions approved on April 17, 2014 and February 5, 2015, which authorized the County of Westchester, acting on behalf of the Westchester-Putnam Local Workforce Investment Board, to enter into agreements with fifty-eight (58) training providers for the provision of vocational training services to adult, dislocated workers, and youth pursuant to the provisions of Title I of the Workforce Investment Act of 1998, as amended, for the period July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2015, for a total aggregate amount not-to-exceed \$300,000, by adding five (5) new vendors to the list of providers set forth in the resolutions.

By resolution approved on September 5, 2013 (the "September 5th Resolution"), your Honorable Board authorized the County of Westchester, acting on behalf of the Westchester-Putnam Local Workforce Investment Board (the "County"), to enter into an agreement with each of the fifty-one (51) training providers listed in the September 5th Resolution, pursuant to which each provider would provide vocational training services to adult, dislocated workers, and youth pursuant to the provisions of Title I of the Workforce Investment Act of 1998, as amended, ("WIA") for the period July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2015, for a total aggregate amount not-to-exceed \$300,000.

Thereafter, by resolution approved April 17, 2014 (the "April 17th Resolution"), your Honorable Board authorized the County to amend the September 5th Resolution in order to add two (2) new training providers, Six Sigma Associates, Inc. and Attababy Jobs, to the list of training providers set forth in the September 5th Resolution, thereby increasing the total number of training providers from 51 to 53. The April 17th Resolution further authorized the County to amend the September 5th Resolution to correct the name of one of the listed providers, Lehman College, from Lehman College to "Lehman College, CUNY".

Thereafter, by resolution approved on February 5, 2015 (the "February 5th Resolution"), your Honorable Board authorized the County to amend the September 5th Resolution, as amended by the April 17th Resolution, in order to add five (5) new training providers as listed in the February 5th Resolution, to the list of training providers set forth in the September 5th Resolution, thereby increasing the total number of training providers from 53 to 58.

Five (5) new organizations, as listed below, have requested approval to serve as Workforce Investment Board Eligible Training Providers. These vendors have registered on both the New York State Training Provider Website and on the One Stop site and were selected based upon their expertise and experience in providing the necessary training services. Accordingly, authority is respectfully requested to amend the September 5th Resolution, as amended by the April 17th Resolution and the February 5th Resolution, in order to add the five (5) new training providers listed below to the list of training providers set forth in the September 5th Resolution, thereby increasing the total number of training providers from 58 to 63.
