The 2016 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required to permanently divert flow from a County owned inverted sanitary sewer siphon located at the intersection of Snowden Avenue, North Water Street and Broadway in the Village of Ossining to a new gravity sanitary sewer to be constructed in an easement that has been acquired through the Village owned Snowden Park and along Broadway.

The objective of this contract is to eliminate the County owned inverted sanitary sewer siphon that has been identified as a source of odors and manhole overflows in the immediate area by replacing it with a gravity sanitary sewer operating with a normal straight vertical grade instead of the depressed vertical grade that is a characteristic of an inverted siphon.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will remove from service the existing inverted sanitary sewer siphon to help mitigate odors and overflows as well as ensure that the operation of the new relocated sanitary sewer is safe and environmentally compliant, thereby enhancing the health and general welfare of the residents of Westchester County.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.
