On June 15, 2016, three (3) bids were received and opened for Contract No. 14-529 for Rehabilitation of Administration Building – Phase II, Mamaroneck Wastewater Treatment Plant, Mamaroneck, New York.

The bids were reviewed by the Department and it was determined that Anjac Enterprises Inc. submitted the low bid in the amount of \$1,685,900.00.

The low bidder has been investigated and it has been found that Anjac Enterprises Inc.:

The objective of this contract is to repair structural elements and to maintain the weather tightness of the existing building.
