On June 1, 2016, four (4) bids were received and opened for Contract No. 15-542 for Rotating Biological Contactors Upgrade – Phase II, Port Chester Wastewater Treatment Plant, Port Chester, New York.

The bids were reviewed by the Department and it was determined that Jett Industries, Inc. submitted the low bid in the amount of \$7,176,190.00, and has proposed the utilization of the following subcontractor: Maraj Electric, Inc. (Electrical Work), 66-15 Thornton Place, Suite 2H, Rego Park, New York 11374.

The low bidder has been investigated and it has been found that Jett Industries, Inc.:

- Performed satisfactory work in the past for the County.
 Past experience has been investigated and found satisfactory.

The objective of this contract is to replace three of the RBC trains used for secondary wastewater treatment which have reached the end of their useful life. Of the seven existing RBC trains at the plant, one was replaced in Phase I, and the additional three will be replaced in a later phase. In replacing the next three RBC trains, this Phase II project will provide the ability to reliably treat wastewater and upgrade the plant for future nitrogen removal as required by the Order-On-Consent with New York State Department of Environmental Conservation.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will ensure that the plant's operations are safe and environmentally compliant, thereby enhancing the health and general welfare of the residents of Westchester County.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.

It is my recommendation that Contract No. 15-542 be awarded to Jett Industries, Inc. in the amount of \$7,176,190.00.
