SUBJECT: Authorization to extend the term of Agreement No. 10-939

with Parsons Brinckerhoff, Inc. until December 31, 2017

Authority of your Honorable Board is requested to extend the term of Agreement No. 10-939 between the County of Westchester ("County") and Parsons Brinckerhoff, Inc. ("Consultant"), One Penn Plaza, New York, New York 10119, for the provision of engineering services associated with the Central Avenue Bus Rapid Transit System Improvements, Cities of White Plains and Yonkers and Town of Greenburgh, New York, until December 31, 2017. The original Agreement, dated February 16, 2011, was for engineering design services with PB Americas, Inc., One Penn Plaza. New York, New York 10119, in connection with the Central Avenue Bus Rapid Transit System Improvements, Cities of White Plains and Yonkers and Town of Greenburgh, New York. The Agreement was thereafter amended by Resolution approved March 8, 2012, for surveying and engineering design services. The Agreement was thereafter modified by Resolution approved May 3, 2012, to correct the name of the Consultant to Parsons Brinckerhoff, Inc. The Agreement was thereafter further amended by Resolution approved July 22, 2014, for construction administration services and to extend the term to December 31, 2016. The current total fee for the Agreement plus Amendments is \$598,701.25.

The County has been satisfied with the quality of services provided by the Consultant to date. The physical construction work associated with this project is substantially complete by the contractor. The Consultant is still currently in the process of providing construction administration services. Therefore, the professional services of the Consultant will be required beyond the current completion date in order to complete the construction administration services and project close out services. Attached is a Resolution requesting an extension of the agreement until December 31, 2017 with no increase in the not to exceed amount of \$598,701.25.

The objective of this project is to make improvements to the Central Avenue corridor by implementing a Bus Rapid Transit System. Central Avenue between White Plains and the Bronx/Westchester County line is one of the busiest and most congested transit corridors in Westchester County. A study of the corridor as a potential site for Bus Rapid Transit service has recommended a number of interim improvements to traffic signals, intersections, and pedestrian access facilities that will produce traffic decongestion and transit running time reductions. This project will implement the most cost-effective and environmentally compliant technologies available. This agreement will benefit the public as it will enhance traffic flow along the Central Avenue corridor.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the consultant and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of tasks. It is recognized and understood that the County shall evaluate the performance of this contract by the consultant and shall use such evaluation in deciding to award future contracts to the consultant.

I urge your favorable consideration of the annexed proposed Resolution.
