Re: **Authority for the County to enter into an MOU to accept a grant from the Redlich Horowitz Foundation in the sum of \$240,000 to increase family-based placement, including Kinship foster care, and reduce congregate care placement for customers of the Department of Social Services receiving foster care services for the term commencing July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2019.**

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The Department of Social Services (“Department”) applied for a grant from the Redlich Horowitz Foundation for Increasing Family-based Care in New York Counties, and in May was awarded a grant in the sum of \$240,000 (the “Grant”), to increase the use of family-based placements (including kinship foster homes), particularly therapeutic foster homes in order to reduce the use of congregate foster care. The funds received from this grant will fund the salary of a Department Program Administrator (Family-based care and Permanency Champion), will be paid pursuant to an approved budget and will further enable the Department to empower its customers to become independent and to ensure the health, safety and protection of vulnerable children in Westchester County. The County will provide a match in the sum of \$258,279 over the term of the Grant, of in-kind Department services including salaries, benefits, supplies and training.

Authority is therefore requested to enter into a MOU to accept the Grant with the Redlich Horowitz Foundation to increase family-based foster care and reduce congregate care in Westchester County in the sum of \$240,000 for the term July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2019.

Pursuant to the proposed MOU, the County would have the goal of reducing placement in congregate care to 15% over the term of the MOU.

The MOU would serve the public purpose of providing fund to reduce foster care placements in congregate care, thereby saving taxpayer funds. The MOU would also potentially allow families to stay together avoiding institutional foster care placement.

Accordingly, authority is respectfully requested from your Honorable Board to authorize the County to enter into an MOU to accept the Grant with Redlich Horwitz foundation. A resolution is annexed hereto, which I recommend for your favorable consideration.
