The 2018 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of all labor, material and equipment required for the rehabilitation of the Glen Island Park seawalls around the Harbor Club and the two pavilions, the west pavilion and the east pavilion, including repairs to the concrete footings, walls, masonry clad pilasters, and concrete deck slab. Work also includes repairs to the face of seawalls, replacing precast concrete caps, steel railings and sidewalks.

The objective of this contract is to repair substandard structure elements to the seawalls and pavilions.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by repairing the damaged seawalls at Glen Island Park around the Harbor Club and the two pavilions.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.

The Bond Underwriter or Surety must appear on the U.S. Treasury's listing of approved sureties (Department Circular 570) and all Sureties must be licensed to transact business in New York as a surety company; and be it further
