RE: **Resolution authorizing the County of Westchester (the "County") to enter into an agreement with the United States of America, acting by and through its Drug Enforcement Administration ("DEA") permitting the County, acting by and through its Department of Public Safety to participate in the Tactical Diversion Squad Task Force for the period from October 1, 2018, through September 30, 2019.**

Authority is hereby requested for the County, acting by and through its Department of Public Safety ("Department"), to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement") with the United States of America, acting by and through its DEA permitting the County, to continue participation in the Tactical Diversion Squad Task Force ("Task Force"). The term will be October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019. Participation consists of the assignment of one (1) sergeant and one (1) detective to the Task Force under the supervision and control of the DEA Supervisory Special Agent assigned to the Task Force. Pursuant to the Agreement, the DEA will reimburse the County for overtime expenses in the amount of \$36,688.

The public purpose of the Agreement is to investigate, disrupt and dismantle individuals and/or organizations involved in diversion schemes of controlled pharmaceuticals and/or listed chemicals in the New York Metropolitan area.

The goals and objectives of the Agreement are to continue the operation of the Tactical Diversion Squad Task Force ("TDS") and to investigate and prosecute illicit drug trafficking in Westchester County. As drug trafficking increases nationwide, DEA recognized the need for cooperation and coordination of drug enforcement efforts with their state and local counterparts. This cooperation provides several advantages to all participating agencies such as Westchester County.

The goals and objectives of the Agreement will support the public safety and/or welfare by removing large quantities of drugs destined for the streets of Westchester. By collaborating enforcement activities of County and local law enforcement agencies, they will be more able to thwart illegal drug activity that has a substantial and detrimental effect to the health and welfare of the people in Westchester County and its surrounding areas.

The goals and objectives of the Agreement will be tracked and monitored by the DEA, the United States Department of Justice, the Comptroller General of the United States, and any of their duly authorized agents and representations. The officer assigned to the TDS shall adhere to DEA policies, procedures and guidelines including conduct, property, reporting systems, evidence handling and use of firearms. The Department shall maintain all such reports and records for audit and examination.

I certify that my department, a) has copies of, or access to, applicable laws, rules, regulations, grant applications, and grant agreements (including any master grant agreement), as well as any guidance or instructions received from the agency making the grant (the “Grant Terms”), b) has reviewed the Grant Terms, c) is aware of and understands all of the Grant Terms, and d) can and will comply with all of the Grant Terms.

Wherefore, authority is respectfully sought for the County of Westchester to enter into this agreement.
