Re: Authority to enter into a grant agreement with the United States Department of Homeland Security, under its 2018 Port Security Grant Program, for a term commencing September 1, 2018 and expiring August 31, 2021, pursuant to which the County of Westchester will accept a grant in an amount not-to-exceed \$435,000.00 (Grant No. EMW-2018-PU-00149) and agree to contribute a cost match in the amount of \$145,000.00 of non-Federal funds, or 25 percent of the total approved project cost of \$580,000.00, to purchase a new maritime patrol vessel.

Attached for your consideration is a Resolution which, if approved by your Honorable Board, would authorize the County of Westchester ("County"), acting by and through its Department of Public Safety ("Department"), to enter into a grant agreement ("Agreement") with the United States Department of Homeland Security ("DHS"), under its 2018 Port Security Grant Program, for a term commencing on September 1, 2018 and expiring on August 31, 2021, pursuant to which the County will accept a grant in an amount not-to-exceed \$435,000.00, upon presentation to DHS of an invoice together with supporting documentation, to purchase a new maritime patrol vessel. Under the Agreement, the County will contribute a cost match in the amount of \$145,000.00 of non-Federal funds, or 25 percent of the total approved project cost of \$580,000.00, towards the purchase of said maritime patrol vessel.

The goal and objective of the Agreement will be tracked and monitored by the staff of the Department.
