Towns of Harrison and North Castle and Village of Rye Brook, New York

The Airport Special Revenue Fund contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required for painting lines on Airport runways, taxiways, and related infrastructure and to remove rubber and paint from surfaces including the runways in conformance with Federal Aviation Administration ("FAA") rules and regulations. This contract is for a term of three (3) years with one two (2) year renewal at the discretion of the County of Westchester ("County").

The objective of this contract is to maintain the runways, taxiways, and related infrastructure in a proper condition for the safe operation of aircraft and the traveling public.

This contract is in the public's best interest by maintaining a safe airfield in compliance with FAA regulations.

As expenditures are made pursuant to this authorization, detailed records will be kept in the County's on-line financial system. These records will be easily accessible by Finance, Budget and department staff and will be reviewed regularly to ensure that funds are used appropriately.

Payment for this contract will be made from the Airport Special Revenue Fund, not the County General Fund and will not impact the County tax levy.

Upon communication from the Commissioner of Public Works and Transportation, be it

RESOLVED, that the Commissioner of Public Works and Transportation be and hereby is authorized to solicit bids by public advertisement on the following contract:

and be it further

RESOLVED, that adequate and sufficient security for the faithful performance of this contract shall be deemed to be retainage of 5% of all work completed on an annual basis. Upon each annual anniversary the contractor may request payment of said retainage with the successful completion of all work performed during that period; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this advertisement for bids will state that pursuant to Chapter 308 of the Laws of the County of Westchester, the policy of the County is to encourage the meaningful and significant participation on County contracts for business enterprises owned by persons of color and women - Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) and Women Business Enterprise (WBE); and be it further
