On April 17, 2019 the County of Westchester ("County") received and opened four (4) bids for Contract No. 19-500 to Rehabilitate Runway 16/34, Westchester County Airport, Towns of Harrison and North Castle and Village of Rye Brook, New York.

The bids were reviewed by the Department of Public Works and Transportation ("Department") and it was determined that Tully Construction Co./Intercounty Paving Associates of NY, LLC submitted the low bid in the amount of \$21,654,180.00, and has proposed the use of the following subcontractors: Verde Electric Maintenance Corporation (Electrical Work), 89 Edison Avenue, Mount Vernon, New York 10550; and Safety Marking, Inc. (Runway Pavement Markings), 255 Hancock Avenue, Bridgeport, Connecticut 06605.

The low bidder has been investigated and it has been found that Tully Construction Co./Intercounty Paving Associates of NY, LLC:

- Performed satisfactory work in the past for the County.  
 Past experience has been investigated and found satisfactory.

The objective of this contract is to provide safety improvements on Runway 16/34.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by improving runway safety to meet Federal Aviation Administration safety standards and guidelines.

The Department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.

Payment for this entire contract will be made from Federal Aviation Administration Funds, New York State Funds and the Airport Special Revenue Fund, not the County General Fund and will not impact the County tax levy.

It is my recommendation that Contract No. 19-500 be awarded to Tully Construction Co./Intercounty Paving Associates of NY, LLC in the amount of \$21,654,180.00.
