SUBJECT: Authority to enter into a grant agreement (IT-1576) with New York State, acting

by and through its Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services, in order to accept a grant awarded to the County under New York State's 2019-20 Public Safety Answering Points Operations Grant Program, in the amount of \$127,807.00 for the period from January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020.

Authority is respectfully requested from your Honorable Board for the County of Westchester (the "County") to enter into a grant agreement with New York State, acting by and through its Division of Horneland Security and Emergency Services, ("DHSES") in order to accept a grant awarded to the County by DHSES under New York State's 2019-20 Public Safety Answering Points Operations Grant Program, in the amount of One Hundred and Twenty-Seven Thousand Eight Hundred and Seven Dollars (\$127,807.00), for the period from January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020, for eligible public safety call-taking and dispatching expenses (the "Grant Agreement").

The proposed Grant Agreement will serve a public purpose by making available to the County certain additional, DHSES funds that the County can use for eligible public safety call-taking and dispatching expenses.

The goal and objective of the proposed Grant Agreement is to make available to the County certain additional, DHSES funds that the County can use for eligible public safety call-taking and dispatching expenses

The goal and objective of the proposed Grant Agreement is in the best interests of the County in terms of the public health, safety and general welfare, as additional, DHSES funds being available for eligible public safety call-taking and dispatching expenses will help support such public safety-related activities.

The goal and objective of the proposed Grant Agreement is also in the best interests of the County in terms of fiscal responsibility, as it will make available to the County certain additional, DHSES funds that the County can use for the aforementioned expenses.

The goal and objective of the proposed Grant Agreement will be tracked and monitored by the Department of Information Technology.

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized designee be and hereby is authorized and empowered to execute any and all documents and take any actions necessary to effectuate the purposes hereof.
