RE: Resolution exempting from the Westchester County Procurement Policy all agreements between Westchester County and sign language interpreters for sign language interpretation services for the period from January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020, each in an amount not-to exceed \$2,000 per interpreter

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Authority of your Honorable Board is hereby requested, on behalf of the County of Westchester (the "County") by and through its Office for People with Disabilities (the "Office") to exempt from the Westchester County Procurement Policy and Procedures (the "Procurement Policy") all sign language interpretation agreements for the period from January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020, each in an amount not-to-exceed \$2,000 per interpreter.

Pursuant to Section 3(a)xxi, the requirements of the Procurement Policy are not applicable to any procurement for which this Honorable Board determines, by resolution, that compliance with the policy would not be in the best interests of the County. The Office hereby seeks to exempt the procurement of the 2020 sign language interpreter agreements from the application of the Procurement Policy.

Price competition does not exist, as the current rate set by the County of \$65.00 per hour paid to all sign language interpreters who hold a contract with the County is below the standard market rate compared to other institutions throughout the County ranging from \$70.00 to \$125.00 per hour as follows: Mercy College pays as low as approximately \$70.00 per hour and up, depending on the level of the interpreter's skill set, Monroe College pays approximately \$80.00 per hour and up, and ACCES-VR pays approximately \$72.00 per hour and up. The Office advertises the opportunity to become a sign language interpreter on its website.

The agreements for the period January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020 will include additional services not included in prior years. These agreements will include an hourly rate of \$75.00 for emergency interpreter services provided with less than three hours prior notice, for services that are provided outside of standard business hours (between 6:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.), and for services provided on Saturdays and Sundays.

These agreements are in the best interests of the residents of the County and serve a public purpose in that they will provide an important service to those who may not otherwise be able to obtain this service.

The Office offers all sign language interpreters the opportunity to obtain a contract with the County for sign language interpreter services. The website for the Office advertises that this opportunity is open to all sign language interpreters.

Accordingly, I recommend and urge your Honorable Board's approval of the annexed Resolution.
