The 2010 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required to install new raised reflectorized pavement markers between Cemetery Road and Lafayette Avenue on the Bronx River Parkway. Additionally, lens and reflector units will be replaced as needed between the Sprain Parkway and Cemetery Road.

The objective of this contract is to improve safety conditions along the Bronx River Parkway.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by meeting the American Association of State Highway & Transportation Officials Standards for Highway Safety. There are no energy or environmental components associated with this project.

If this resolution is not approved, the Parkway will not be in compliance with the American Association of State Highway & Transportation Officials Standards for Highway Safety.

The department will utilize Primavera Software Management tools to track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.

**RESOLVED**, that adequate and sufficient security for the faithful performance of this contract shall be deemed to be receipt of a performance and payment bond in an amount equal to 100% of the total contract amount, and in a form approved by the County Attorney. The Bond Underwriter or Surety must appear on the U.S. Treasury's listing of approved sureties (Department Circular 570) and all Sureties must be licensed to transact business in New York as a surety company; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that this advertisement for bids will state that pursuant to Chapter 308 of the Laws of the County of Westchester, the policy of the County is to encourage the meaningful and significant participation on County contracts for business enterprises owned by persons of color and women - Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) and Women Business Enterprise (WBE); and be it further
