SUBJECT: Authority for the County of Westchester (the “County”), acting on behalf of the Westchester-Putnam Local Workforce Development Board, to amend a resolution approved on May 30, 2019 (the “May 30th Resolution”) which authorized the County to enter into an agreement with each of the fifty-one (51) training providers listed in the May 30th Resolution, pursuant to which each provider would provide vocational training services to adult, dislocated workers, and youth pursuant to the provisions of Title I of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 for the period from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2023, for a total aggregate amount not-to-exceed \$772,736, by 1) adding three (3) new training providers to the list set forth in the May 30th Resolution; and 2) increasing the total not-to-exceed amount by \$300,000.

By resolution approved on May 30, 2019, your Honorable Board authorized the County of Westchester, acting on behalf of the Westchester-Putnam Local Workforce Development Board, (the “County”) to enter into an agreement with each of the fifty-one (51) training providers listed in the May 30th Resolution, pursuant to which each provider would provide vocational training services to adult, dislocated workers, and youth pursuant to the provisions of Title I of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 (“WIOA”), for the period from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2023, for a total aggregate amount not-to-exceed \$772,736.

Three (3) new organizations, as listed below, have requested approval to serve as WIOA Eligible Training Providers. These vendors have registered on both the New York State Training Provider Website and on the One Stop site and were selected based upon their expertise and experience in providing the necessary training services. Accordingly, authority is respectfully requested to amend the May 30th Resolution, in order to add the three (3) new training providers

listed below to the list of training providers set forth in the May 30th Resolution, thereby increasing the total number of training providers from 51 to 54.

* There is no set dollar amount for each individual training provider. The training providers are given referrals on an as-needed basis, with the training providers paid based upon catalogued tuition prices.

In addition, the County will need additional funding to pay for the three new training providers as well as the other training providers on the list. Accordingly, authority is also requested to amend the May 30th Resolution by increasing the total aggregate not-to-exceed amount thereunder by an additional \$300,000, from an amount not-to-exceed \$772,736, to a new amount not-to-exceed \$1,072,736.

Except as otherwise specifically amended hereby, all remaining terms and conditions set forth in the May 30th Resolution shall remain the same.

I respectfully recommend the adoption of the attached Resolution.
