SUBJECT: Authorization to enter into a grant agreement with the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services to accept \$677,783.00 in federal grant funds under the FY2020 State Homeland Security grant program, for the maintenance of County emergency planning activities, for the period September 1, 2020 through August 31, 2023.

Authorization is requested for the County of Westchester (the "County"), acting by and through its Department of Emergency Services (the "Department"), to enter into a grant agreement – DHSES WM20974500 (the "Grant Agreement") with the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services (the "State") to accept federal grant funds to assist the County in its efforts to prevent terrorist attacks and mitigate against man-made and natural hazards, protect County residents, the County's critical infrastructure and key resources, and prepare to respond to and recover from both man-made and natural disasters in compliance with the FY2020 State Homeland Security grant program ("FY2020 SHSP Grant Program") for the period September 1, 2020 through August 31, 2023, for a total amount not-to-exceed \$677,783.00.

The Grant Agreement will require the County to indemnify the State as follows:

"The [County] shall be solely responsible and answerable in damages for any and all accidents and/or injuries to persons (including death) or property arising out of or related to the services to be rendered by the County or its subcontractors pursuant to this [Grant Agreement]. The [County] shall indemnify and hold harmless the State and its officers and employees from claims, suits, actions, damages and cost of every nature arising out of the provision of services pursuant to the [Grant Agreement]."

This Grant Agreement will serve the public's best interest as it will enhance emergency preparedness and thereby preserve the health, safety and general welfare of County residents. The goals and objectives of this program are to address vulnerabilities and develop capabilities to meet target capabilities as outlined in the Federal Guidelines. This includes providing assistance to and support for surveillance, detection, interdiction, response, mitigation, operations and recovery from threats or acts of terrorism and man-made and natural hazards.

The goals and objectives of this Grant Agreement are to address vulnerabilities and develop capabilities to meet target capabilities as outlined in the federal Homeland Security Grant Program guidelines. This includes providing assistance to and support for surveillance, detection, interdiction, response, mitigation, operations and recovery from man-made and natural disasters.

Additionally, this Grant Agreement will enhance common planning and operational protocols and improve emergency responder skills and capabilities. The Department will be able to monitor the effectiveness of this effort through a series of performance measures required by the State.

I certify that my department, a) has copies of, or access to, all applicable laws, rules, regulations, grant applications, and grant agreements (including any master grant agreement), as well as any guidance or instructions received from the agency making the grant (the "Grant Terms), b) has reviewed the Grant Terms, c) is aware of and understands all of the Grant Terms, and d) can and will comply with all of the Grant Terms.
