The 2020 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required for the reconstruction of the Playland Towers, restoration of the West Cross Axis Food Facilities, restoration of the Main and West Cross Axis Restroom Facilities and rehabilitation of the North and South Administration Buildings. Work includes all associated mechanical, electrical and site work

In accordance with Chapter 635 of the Laws of Westchester County, the Department of Public Works and Transportation has evaluated the needs of this project and determined that a Project Labor Agreement (PLA) will benefit and enhance the interests of the County in the timely and efficient completion of the project.
