SUBJECT: Authority to exercise the County of Westchester's option to extend the term of an agreement with Sirina Protection Systems Corp. for one two (2) year option period, thereby increasing the amount of the agreement by \$77,833.26 and extending the term of the agreement through March 31, 2023 (Contract No. 17-216).

By Resolution approved on March 15, 2018 (the "March 15th Resolution"), your Honorable Board awarded Contract No. 17-216 to Sirina Protection Systems Corp. ("Sirina Protection Systems"). The March 15th Resolution authorized the County of Westchester (the "County") to enter into Contract No. 17-216 with Sirina Protection Systems, pursuant to which Sirina Protection Systems was to provide Fire Suppression System Service and Maintenance, Various Locations, Westchester County, New York for the amount of \$116,749.89 for the period of April 1, 2018 through March 31, 2021, ("Contract No. 17-216" or the "Agreement"), with the County having the sole option to extend the Agreement for one (1) two (2) year option period.

The County now seeks authority from your Honorable Board to 1) exercise the two (2) year renewal option and extend the termination date of the Agreement from March 31, 2021 to March 31, 2023; and 2) increase the amount of the Agreement by \$77,833.26 from an amount of \$116,749.89 to a new total amount not to exceed \$194,583.15.

All other terms and conditions of the March 15, 2018 Resolution and the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect and unchanged.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by providing a safe and code compliant work environment at various County facilities.

As expenditures are made pursuant to this authorization, detailed records will be kept in the County's on-line financial system. These records will be easily accessible by Finance, Budget and department staff and will be reviewed regularly to ensure that funds are used appropriately.
