The 2021 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required for rehabilitation of the Crotonville Pumping Station in the Ossining Sanitary Sewer District in Ossining, New York. Work includes rehabilitation or replacement of various equipment and systems including pumps, motors, drives, controls, valves, piping, electrical, heating, ventilation, chemical feed and security systems, emergency generator, bar screen, and installation of flood hazard mitigation measures.

In accordance with Chapter 635 of the Laws of Westchester County, the Department of Public Works and Transportation has evaluated the needs of this project and determined that a Project Labor Agreement (PLA) will benefit and enhance the interests of the County in the timely and efficient completion of the project. The Contractor to whom this contract is awarded will be required to execute a PLA.

The objective of this contract is to prevent failure, including the occurrence of a sewage overflow emergency, that could allow sewage into the surrounding properties and cause violations of the pumping station's State Pollutant Discharge Elimination System ("SPDES") Permit.

This contract will benefit the public as it will ensure that the facility's operations are safe and environmentally compliant, thereby enhancing the health and general welfare of the residents of Westchester County.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.
