The 2021 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required to construct a new steel sheet pile bulkhead around the existing effluent Outfall Jetty, located within the Village of Mamaroneck's Harbor Island Park. The new steel sheet pile bulkhead, using marine grade steel, will be constructed to the same finished elevation as the existing steel bulkhead and approximately 2 feet to the waterside of the existing steel bulkhead. Some portions of the new bulkhead will be constructed using stone revetment to the waterside of the existing bulkhead in areas where the new steel sheet piling is not being installed. A new concrete pile cap will be constructed on top of the new steel sheet piling which will also serve as a foundation for a new perimeter fence. In addition, pervious pavement walkways, decorative lighting, benches, fencing, and grass areas will be installed on the surface area of the rehabilitated jetty.

The objective of this contract is to prevent failure of the existing steel sheet piling system which provides protection for one of the two Wastewater Effluent Outfalls from the Mamaroneck Wastewater Treatment Plant, which has reached the end of its useful life and requires rehabilitation.

This contract will benefit the public as it will ensure that the facility's operations are safe and environmentally compliant, thereby enhancing the health and general welfare of the residents of Westchester County.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.

RESOLVED, that adequate and sufficient security for the faithful performance of this contract shall be deemed to be receipt of a performance and payment bond in an amount equal to 100% of the total contract amount, and in a form approved by the County Attorney. The Bond Underwriter or Surety must appear on the U.S. Treasury's listing of approved sureties (Department Circular 570) and all Sureties must be licensed to transact business in New York as a surety company; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this advertisement for bids will state that pursuant to Chapter 308 of the Laws of the County of Westchester, the policy of the County is to encourage the meaningful and significant participation on County contracts for business enterprises owned by persons of color and women - Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) and Women Business Enterprise (WBE); and be it further
