The 2021 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required to rehabilitate the Primary Settling Tank influent channel deck including repair of the structural expansion joints within the tanks, replacement of the sluice gates and addition of electric actuators at the Primary Splitter Box, repair of the masonry perimeter screening wall behind the Rotating Biological Contactor (RBC) Tanks, upgrading of all chemical transfer locations and containment areas including replacement of the Chemical Bulk Storage (CBS) Tanks, and rehabilitation of the Effluent Pump Station at the Sludge Processing Building.

In accordance with Chapter 635 of the Laws of Westchester County, the Department of Public Works and Transportation has evaluated the needs of this project and determined that a Project Labor Agreement (PLA) will benefit and enhance the interests of the County in the timely and efficient completion of the project. The Contractor to whom this contract is awarded will be required to execute a PLA.

The objective of this project will be to structurally rehabilitate the Primary Settling Tanks deck and internal expansion joints to prevent influent leakage from the tanks to the surrounding areas, as well as rehabilitate various system processes and chemical storage facilities as identified in an asset management pilot study previously performed at the Plant. This will prevent violations of the treatment plant's State Pollutant Discharge Elimination System ("SPDES") Permit and provide for increased efficiency, reliability of equipment and ease of maintenance.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it ensures that the facility meets ongoing operational needs and complies with current building codes.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.

RESOLVED, that adequate and sufficient security for the faithful performance of this contract shall be deemed to be receipt of a performance and payment bond in an amount equal to 100% of the total contract amount, and in a form approved by the County Attorney. The Bond Underwriter or Surety must appear on the U.S. Treasury's listing of approved sureties (Department Circular 570) and all Sureties must be licensed to transact business in New York as a surety company; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this advertisement for bids will state that pursuant to Chapter 308 of the Laws of the County of Westchester, the policy of the County is to encourage the meaningful and significant participation on County contracts for business enterprises owned by persons of color and women - Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) and Women Business Enterprise (WBE); and be it further
