Re: Resolution authorizing the County of Westchester, acting by and through the District Attorney's Office, to amend two (2) previous resolutions 1) exempting an agreement with the Center for Court Innovation from the Westchester County Procurement Policy, and 2) authorizing the County to enter into an agreement with the Center for Court Innovation, for the provision of consulting services in connection with the development and implementation of a prosecutor-led diversion program in order to correct and change the legal name of the consultant to Fund For the City of New York, Inc.

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On April 8, 2021, your Honorable Board approved the following resolutions: 1) Resolution to exempt from the Westchester County Procurement Policy the procurement of an agreement with the Center for Court Innovation, for the provision of consulting services in connection with the development and implementation of a prosecutor-led pre-arraignment diversion program, pursuant to Section 3(a)(xxi) of the Westchester County Procurement Policy; and 2) Resolution authorizing the County of Westchester (the "County"), to enter into an agreement with the Center for Court Innovation, for the provision of consulting services in connection with the development and implementation of a prosecutor-led diversion program for a one-year term commencing upon full execution of the agreement, in an amount not-to-exceed \$90,000 (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "April 8<sup>th</sup> Resolutions"). The agreement has not yet been executed.

It has recently come to the County's attention that the consultant named in the April 8<sup>th</sup> Resolutions as "Center for Court Innovation" will be performing the work as "Fund for the City of New York, Inc." Accordingly, it is now respectfully requested to amend the April 8<sup>th</sup> Resolutions in order to change the consultant's name from "Center for Court Innovation" to "Fund for the City of New York, Inc." Except as specifically amended hereby, all remaining terms and conditions set forth in the April 8<sup>th</sup> Resolutions shall remain in full force and effect.

The public purpose of the proposed agreement is to improve and expedite the criminal justice process, creating positive outcomes and alleviating the strain on an overburdened court

system. Performance of the agreement will be tracked and monitored by District Attorney personnel.

Accordingly, approval of the annexed proposed Resolution is requested.

**RESOLVED**, that the County Executive or his duly authorized designee is hereby authorized to execute all documents and take all actions necessary to effectuate the purpose hereof.
