The 2010 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required for milling and resurfacing of Lexington Avenue. Also included is the repair and alteration of existing drainage structures along with the installation of new curbs, handicapped curb cuts, signage, reflectorized markers and pavement markings.

The objective of this contract is to replace substandard areas of asphalt paving, thus addressing the County Executive's priority area: Safety and Security (SS).

This contract is in the public's best interest because it will promote the health and safety of the general public by ensuring that Lexington Avenue meets current codes and standards as well as reducing the County's annual maintenance costs.

The project will provide an environmental benefit by eliminating flooding conditions due to damaged drainage structures.

If this resolution is not approved, the existing substandard pavement areas will continue to deteriorate, resulting in more costly repairs or, possibly, complete replacement in the future.

The department will utilize Primavera Software Management tools to track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.
